

PLANTING OUT SEEDLINGS

1



Dig a hole using a trowel: make sure it is big enough for all the roots. The roots should be below the soil and the leaves above ground.

2



Put the plant in the hole: make sure it is not too deep or too shallow. Adjust the hole until you are happy it is the right size.

3



Firm in the plant: Use your hands to push the soil back around the plant. Gently push it down so the plant is firmly in the ground.

TOP TIP

Weed and water regularly after planting

4



Measure the correct space between plants: dig a hole for the next plant and repeat the previous steps.

5



Water in well: water until there is a puddle of water around your seedling.

6



Label your plants: remember to add a label with the plant name and date of planting.
